

Purpose

Kendall Young Library recognizes its role as a hub for community information. To support this, KYL offers a bulletin board reserved for displaying relevant community announcements and resources.

Policy

The following items may be approved for posting, depending on space availability:

- Announcements of upcoming educational, social, civic, charitable, cultural, or recreational activities.
- Notices from nonprofit organizations, community groups, agencies, or government entities providing services to citizens.
- Fundraising projects organized by nonprofit service organizations
- Nonpartisan election information

The following items will not be approved for posting:

- Petitions for any purpose.
- Solicitations for funds or sale items supporting an individual cause.
- Political materials endorsing a specific candidate or political party.
- Commercial notices, solicitations, business cards, third-party job postings, and retail advertising.

Posting Guidelines

- All postings must be approved by the library director or designated staff member.
- Content must be appropriate for viewing by all ages.
- Items may only be posted on the designated bulletin board — not on adjacent walls, windows, doors or other surfaces at the Library.
- Unapproved materials will be discarded.
- The library may limit the display period for posted items.
- Space may be reserved for ongoing community resources, such as food pantries, crisis services etc.
- KYL assumes no responsibility for preserving or protecting posted materials.

Permission to post does not imply library endorsement of any group's policies, objectives, or beliefs. The use of bulletin board space must not be advertised in any way that suggests endorsement by Kendall Young Library.

Display Cases

Kendall Young Library has several lockable display cases to protect collections while on exhibit. Occasionally, the library may feature collections owned by private individuals or organizations. These exhibits must be educational and of general interest. Final approval for displays will be given by the Director or Assistant Director.

The library's permanent exhibits include:

- Abastenia Eberle sculptures
- Foster Doll collection
- Van Ness Native American collection
- International Doll collection
- Historic medal collection
- Kendall Young memorabilia

These permanent collections remain in their designated cases and are not removed for temporary exhibits.
